- Tools and systems to identify, promote and develop clean energy CDM projects in Argentina
- Canada- Argentina linkages and networks which can be used to identify and design CDM projects in Argentina

Activities

Capacity Building

- Over 1000 participants with representatives from 13 provinces
- 13 capacity building sessions held in 4 provinces
- Specific focus on opportunities for clean energy
- Representatives from various sectors (oil and gas, bagasse, forestry, dairy production, transportation, renewable energy, energy efficiency)

National CDM Project Review System

- Provided ongoing advice and feedback on the CDM review system and other climate change issues
- Produced a CDM Architecture Guide including a comparison of host country review processes, SD criteria, small scale baseline methodology, and funding options

Activities

Project Identification

- Over 20 potential clean energy CDM projects provided with one on one training
- 3 pre-feasibility studies underway
- Two likely CDM projects with a combined potential of 200,000 tonnes/year of CO₂e

Activities

Demonstration Project

- Technology transfer planning and installation design
- Renewable energy technology installation and testing
- Training tools for the community on solar energy systems

La Iniciativa Argentino-Canadiense de Mejora de las Capacidades para el Mecanismo para un Desarrollo Limpio (CACBI) es un proyecto que aborda las prioridades de desarrollo sustentable y los objetivos en materia del cambio climático de la Argentina. La iniciativa CACBI fue desarrollada con el fin de mejorar las capacidades, tanto del gobierno como del sector privado, de crear un futuro de energía sustentable, de intensificar la participación de la Argentina en oportunidades clave, tales como el **mecanismo para un desarrollo limpio**, y de promover la transferencia de tecnología. El proyecto también generará alianzas bilaterales y vínculos económicos entre el Canadá y la Argentina en el ámbito del cambio climático y la energía limpia. The key elements for developing CDM projects in Argentina are in place

- The CDM Office in Argentina has a National CDM Review System in place.
- Foreign investments in industrial projects are foreseen as the national economic situation improves
- Significant level of interest and awareness and increased potential project flow as result of CACBI

- Two communities in the Province of Misiones have solar power installations as well as training and support
- Social and gender equity benefits
- Case Study tool created to outline lessons learned

Results

General

- Argentina has excellent potential for CDM projects given the technical capacity, size and nature of various industries
- Opportunities exist for Canadian technology in biomass, landfill gas, energy management expertise, forestry, oil and gas as well as climate change expertise

Looking into the Future

- Sharing lessons learned within the Mercosur in preparation for COP 10 on climate change issues beyond CDM
- Continue to foster relationships between Canadian and Argentine companies
- The results of CACBI will continue to bear fruit through future activities in the region
