

“John de Gonzague Pollution Prevention Visionary Award”

The John de Gonzague Memorial Pollution Prevention Visionary Award recognizes individuals who inspire and achieve excellence in advancing pollution prevention.

John de Gonzague was a true pioneer in pollution prevention and was instrumental in the development of pollution prevention strategies and policies throughout Canada. John was actively involved in the early work defining what pollution prevention was, creating tools that helped establish it as key component of environmental protection, promoting P2 through other government departments and sharing Canada's P2 experiences internationally. He had an extraordinary ability to create partnerships and he was a leader who inspired his staff and colleagues throughout his career. This Award has been established in John's name not only to recognize other environmental professionals who strive for excellence but also to remind us of our dependence on each other and the value of strong relationships.

The P2 Visionary Award is handed out annually at the Canadian Pollution Prevention Roundtable.

Criteria

The nominees must be Canadian environmental professionals who have demonstrated personal and professional commitment in advancing pollution prevention principles for a period of at least five years in the following areas:

- Setting vision and direction for pollution prevention strategies;
- Leading and directing pollution prevention programs
- Implementing pollution prevention projects
- Collaborating with local, national or international partners to further pollution prevention ideals

Application

Nominate your colleague, team member or a P2 practitioner in another organization. A separate nomination form should be submitted for each P2 Visionary you wish to nominate.

Nominees must be a Canadian environmental professional who has worked in the field of pollution prevention for at least 5 years.

Nominations are kept confidential by the review panel. Entries from past years will be accepted if additional data has been collected or significant changes made
