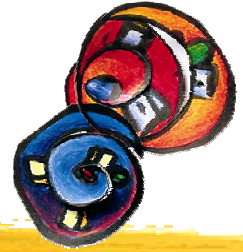

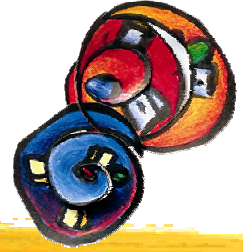

ICLEI's Mission



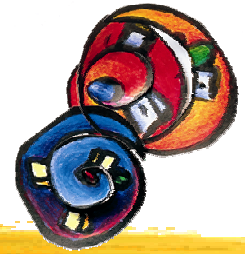

ICLEI Role

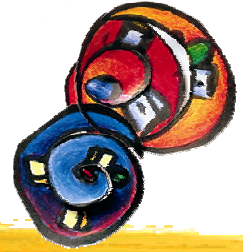


- Build capacity of municipal officials and staff, political leaders, community decision makers

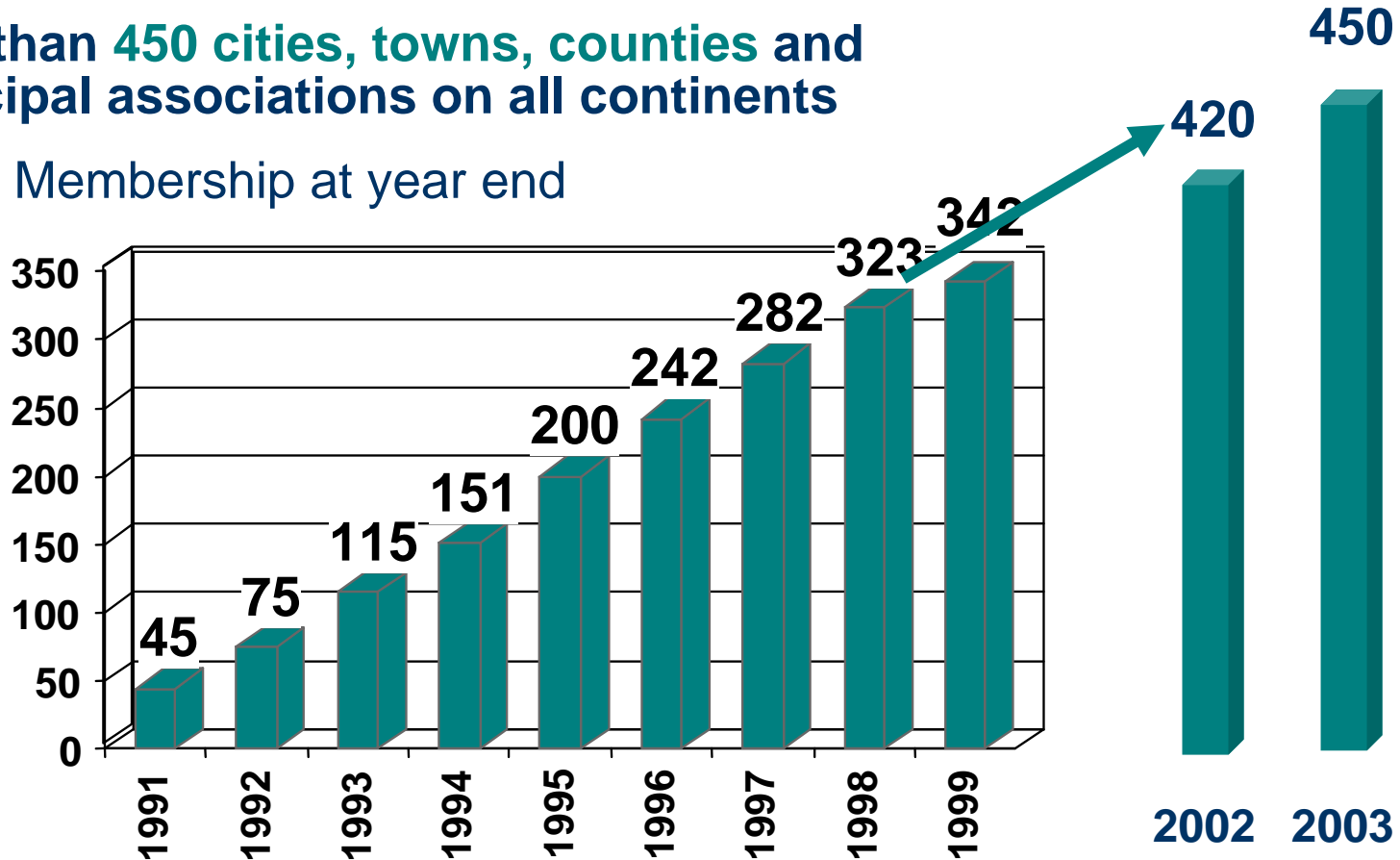

More than 450 cities, towns, counties and municipal associations on all continents

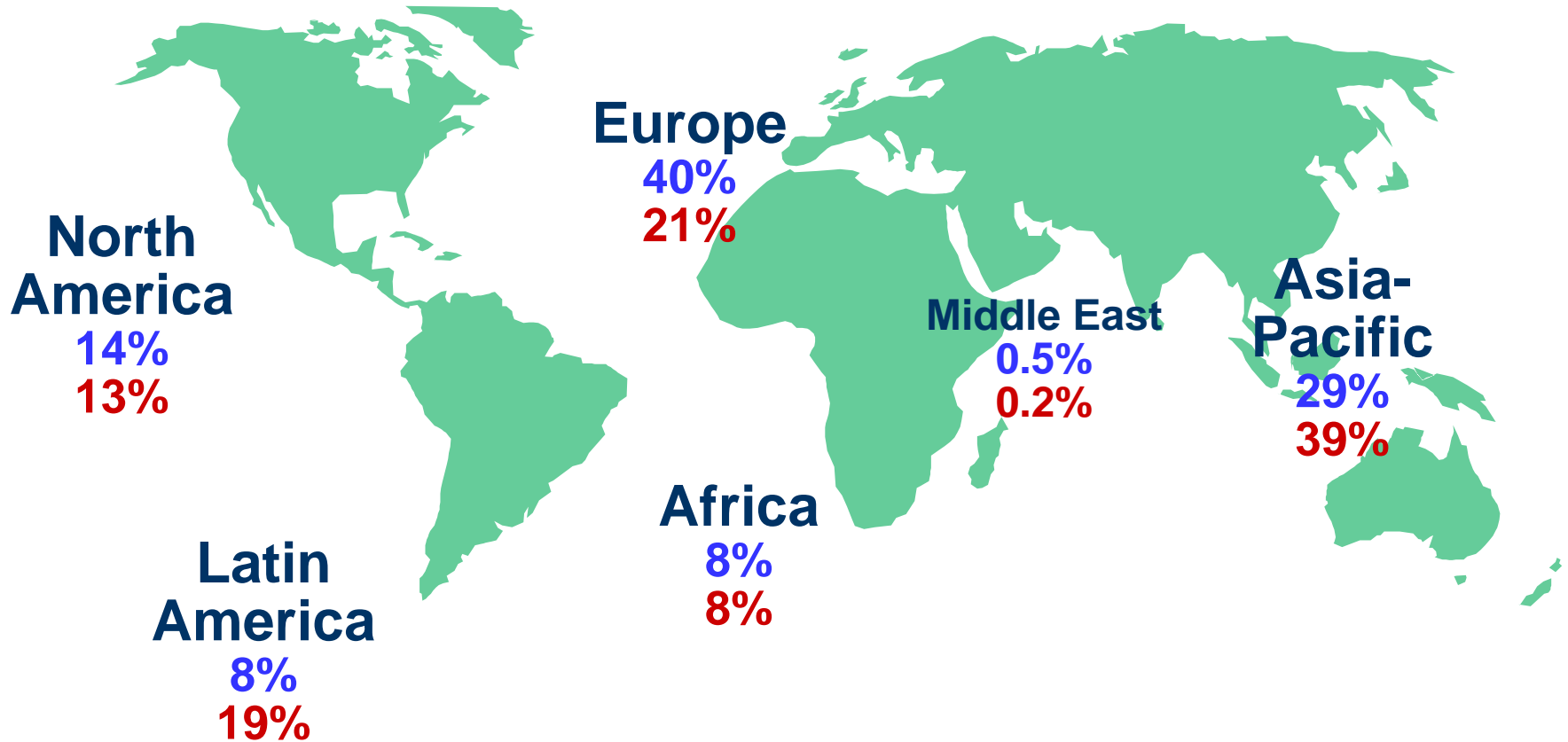
Membership at year end



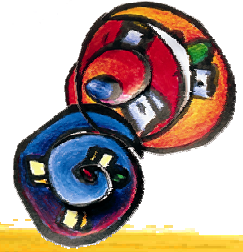
Global representation of Members
